- 1 main Beta engine model B14FD.
- 300 hours, diesel, 14 HP.
- Built 2014.
- Owner/shop manuals included.
- Fresh water heat exchanger cooled engine cooling system.
- Wet exhaust in very good condition.
- Engine room ventilation is natural.
- Engine room housekeeping is in very good condition.

DRIVE:

- Sail Drive, gear manufactured by Twin Disc. model Seaprop 60.
- Built 1990.
- Owner/shop manuals included.
- Prop bronze with 3 blades.
- Steel reinforced fibreglass rudder.
- Stainless steel rudder shaft.

PUMPS & ALARMS:

- Bilge Pump 'Rule", capacity 500 gal per hr.
- Hand Pump 1" discharge.

ELECTRICAL SYSTEM:

- Power Source: 2 12 Volt batteries.
- Wiring insulated copper, age new 1981 and in excellent condition.
- Main Switch and fuse panel with protective lenses on light fixtures.
- Batteries secured & covered.
- Shore power hook up 30 Amp.

FUEL SYSTEM:

- Tanks with 20-gallon capacity located at bow.
- Filler lines and vent lines from approved flex.
- Fuel lines to engine from approved flex to pump, steel from pump to injectors.

DECKS:

- Fibreglass.
- 1 Cleats at bow, 2 at each side.
- Winches Type Sail trimming, 1 each side aft and 1 each side midships hand crank.
- Anchors Danforth, 20' chain ¼ in very good condition.
- Anchor rode 140' nylon 5/8" in very good condition.
- Single aluminum sloop rigged mast with self-furling jib. Rigging is stainless steel.
- Very good condition of sails.

SUPERSTRUCTURE:

- Low fibreglass deck house in very good condition.
- Aft door with escape hatch at bow.

ACCOMMODATION:

• Open cockpit aft.







- In cabin on port side is a navigation station with a working galley on the starboard side.
- Settee mid-ships that makes in to a bunk.
- Port side forward is a water closet with sink and marine head connected to a holding tank.
- At forecastle is a "V" berth.
- Newport diesel heater.

Galley, Mess and Lounge Area:

- Potable fresh water capacity 15.4 gal.
- 3 burner propane cooking stove with oven.
- Propane tank storage locker is vented at the top and bottom to outside. Tanks are well secured.
- Painted fibreglass deck covering.
- Bar Fridge.
- Appearance and house keeping is good.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

- Inflatable 8' 5" dingy and 1 paddle set.
- 2 dry chemical 5 lb fire extinguishers.
- Orion Gun with 5 flares and 4 hand held flares.
- 1 Life Ring on Stern.
